





The doll cried and requested Patrick to save him and not to send him back to the cat. In return, the doll promised Patrick to fulfil his wish.













And keeping his word, the elf started doing his home-work. But sometimes, he needed help as he didn't know all things. Then Patrick had to help him.




Even he did not know anything of human history, it was completely strange to him. Thus, he screamed at him to visit the library, get him more books and help him to read as well.
