
- 1. Sprouting: The practice of germinating seeds to be eaten raw
- 2. Velcro: A fastener made up of two stripes or fabric which stick together when pressed
- 3. Pitcher plant: Plant which traps and eats insects

• Give the reasons:

- 1. **Doctors sometimes advice sick people to eat sprouts.** Ans: Because sprouts are extremely nutritious.
- 2. Seeds kept in refrigerator do not sprout. Ans: Due to low temperature.

Answer the following questions:

- 1. What are the conditions a seed needs to sprout? Ans: All seeds need water, oxygen and proper temperature.
- 2. What do you understand by dispersal of seeds? Why is it important? Ans: It means seeds get scattered from the parent plant. It is important so they do not grow closer to the parent plant.
- How was Velcro discovered? Ans: When George Mestral found some seeds were stick on his clothes and on dog's fur.
- 4. State a few conditions that a seed needs to germinate? Ans: water, oxygen and proper temperature.
