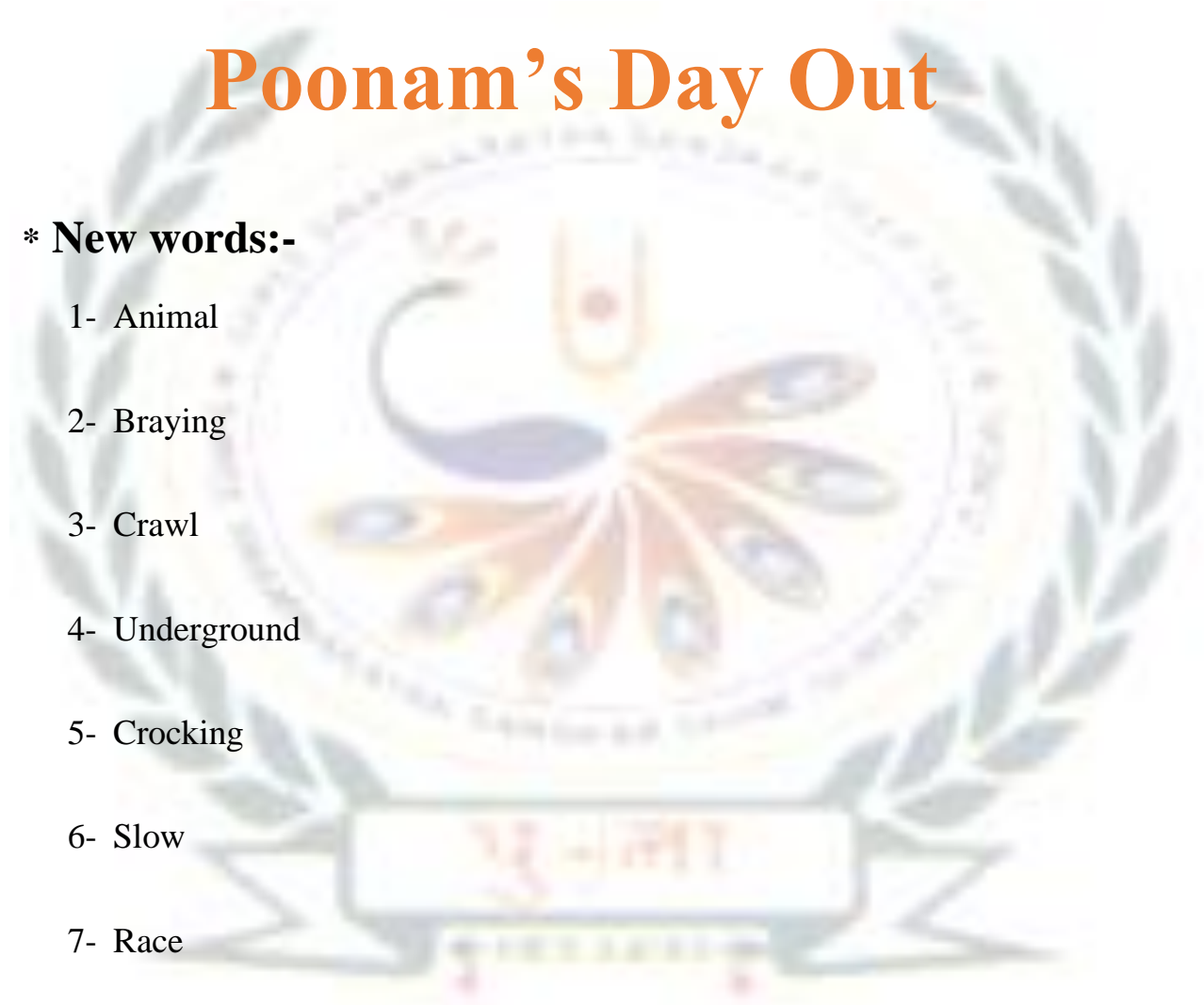

### Word meaning;

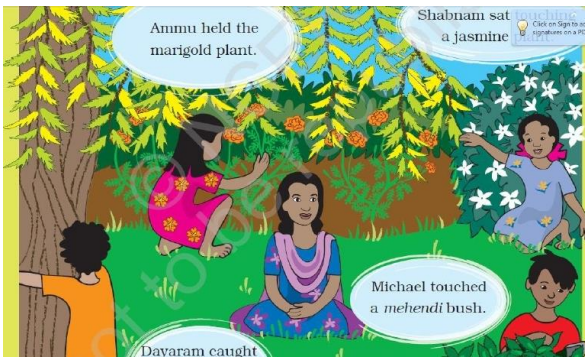
**Trunk-** the thick, main stem of a tree on which branches grow

**Pluck-** to take hold of something and remove it by pulling it out

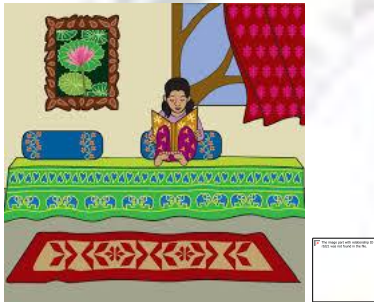
**Hue-** the colour or shade of a colour
