Ans: They have come to celebrate Dussehra.

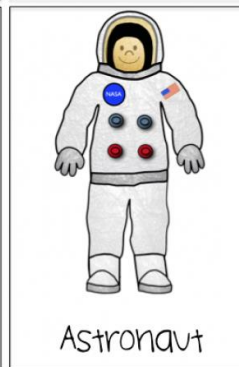
15. What things have Dhanu's mother and aunt prepared?
