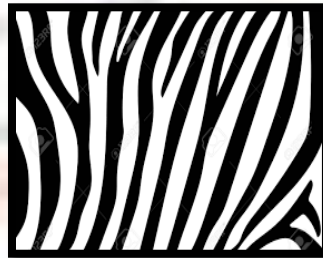
A1. An open box made of wood attached with the rope. A pulley helps the trolley to move across the rope.
