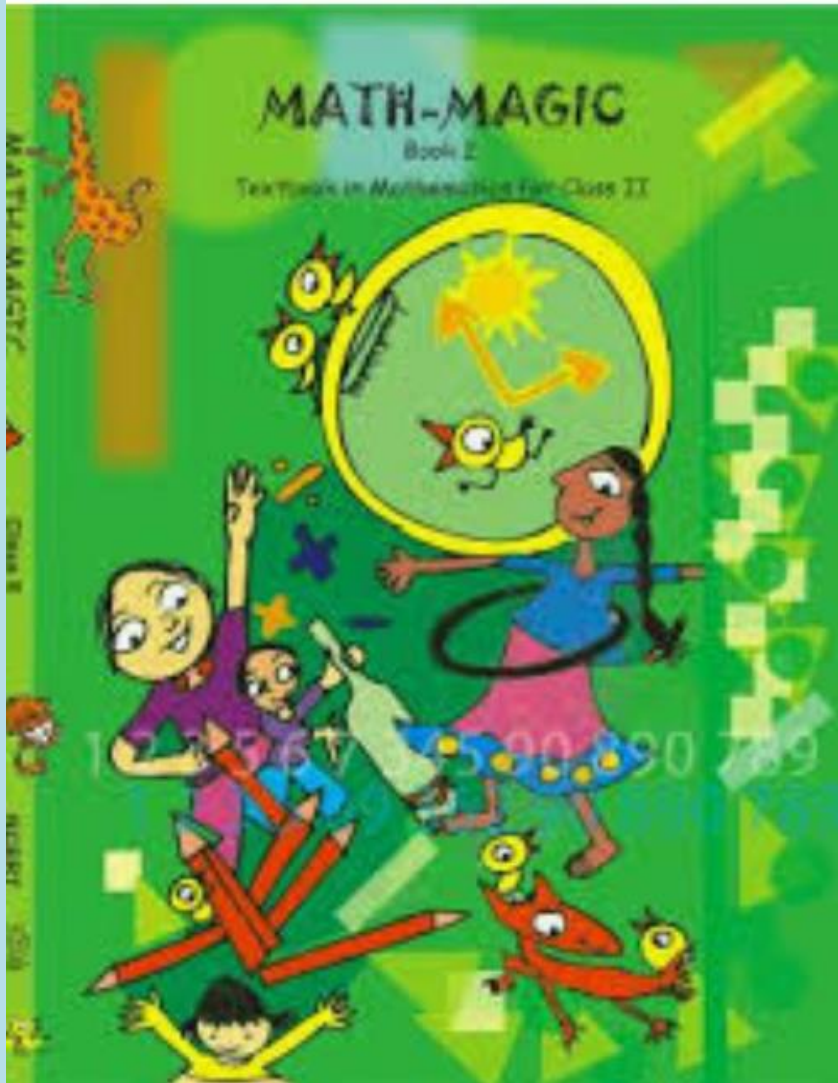

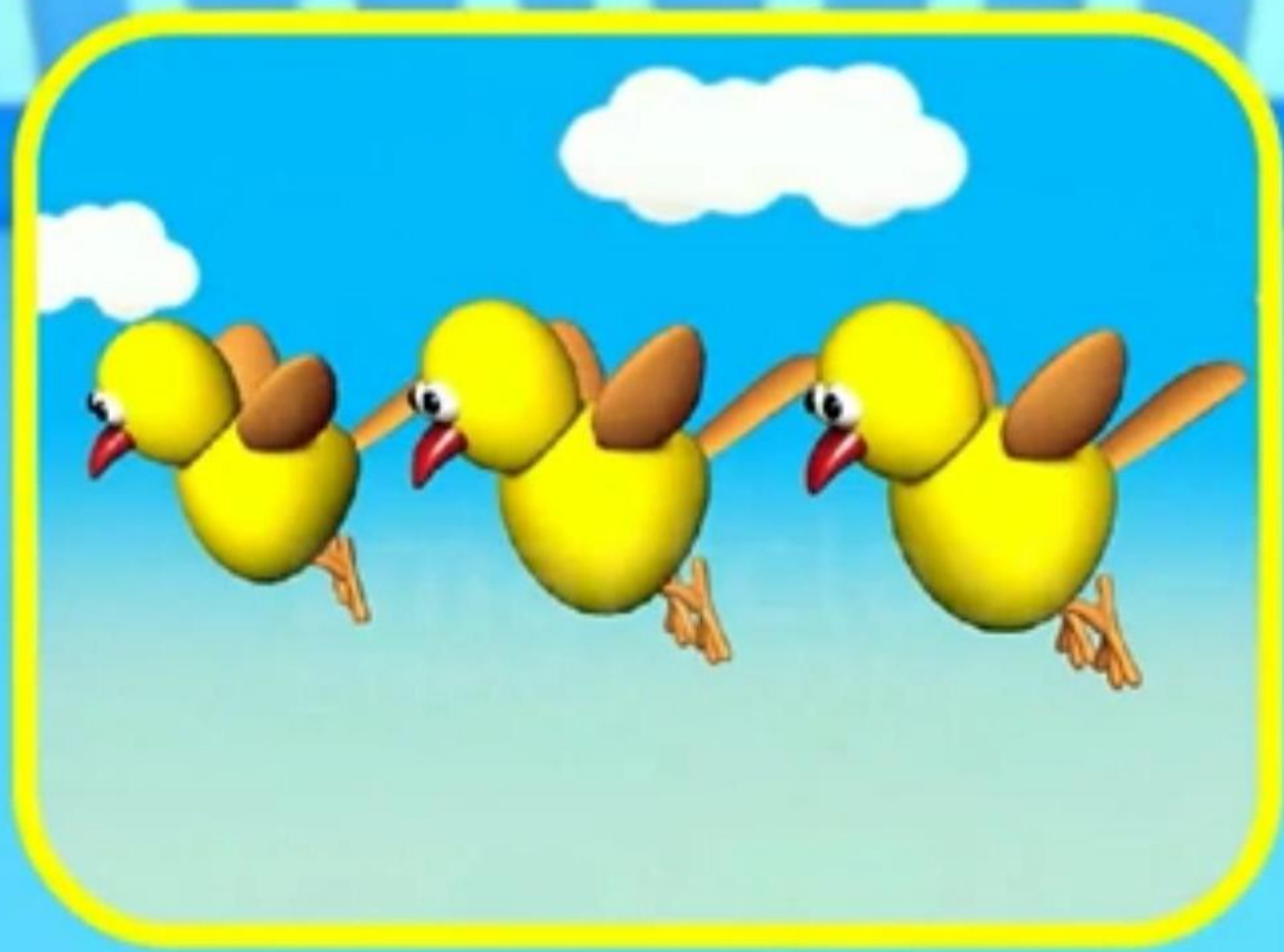


What is group



**Group**



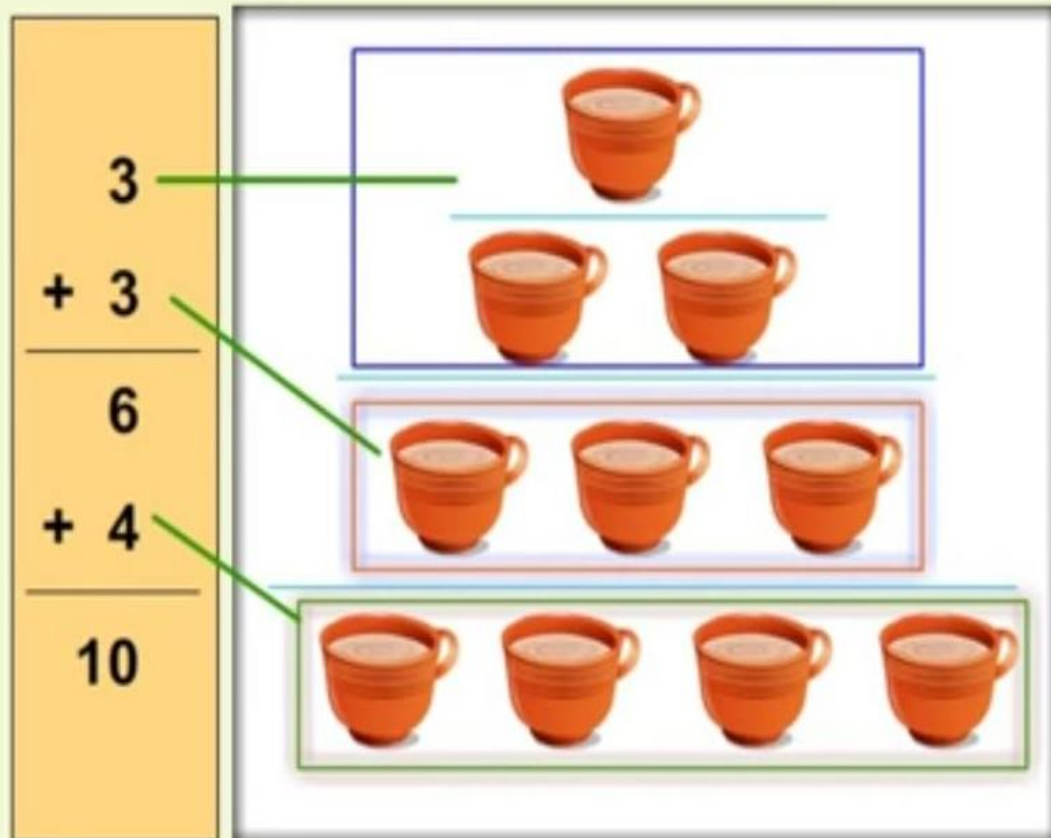

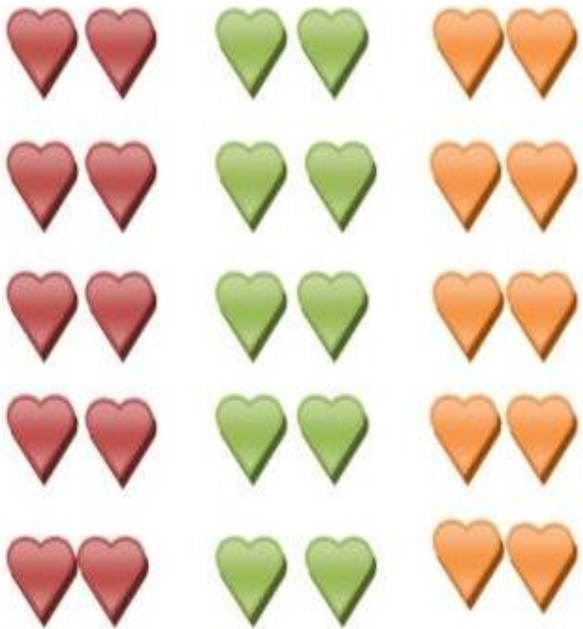

1) How many groups are there? 3

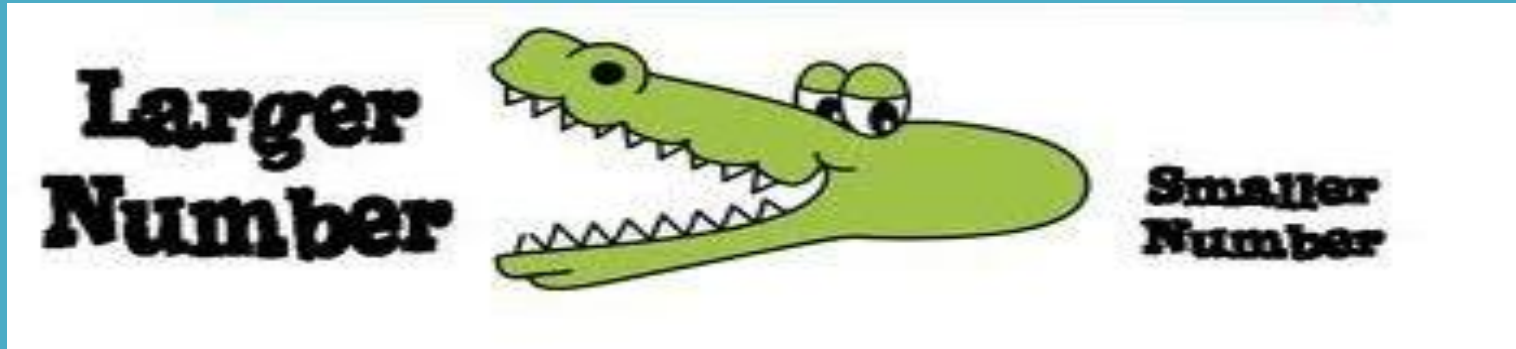
2) How many hearts are there each groups?

Greedy Alice!

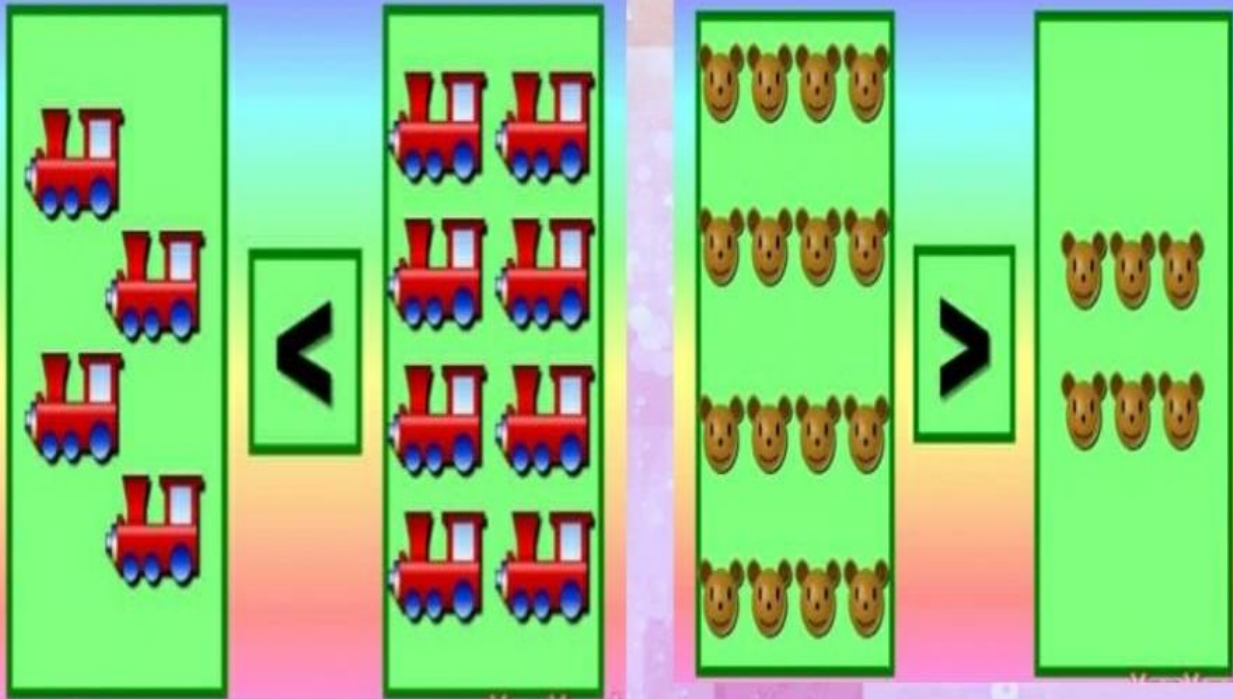
## greater than >

The greater than sign (>) is a comparison sign used in math. It means that one amount or value is greater than another one.

3 is **greater than** 2.

**3 > 2**

# Compare with less than and greater than



37	 Less than	80
61	 Greater than	8
3	 Equal to	3

As we have observed the picture With object then we come to know that open side of comparison sign always toward the more.
